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**COURSES FOR PARAFENCING COACHES, IWAS INTERNATIONAL REFEREES
AND PARAFENCING CLASSIFIERS**

The Brazilian Fencing Confederation-CBE, the Brazilian Paralympic Committee - CPB and the International Wheelchair and Amputee Sports Federation - IWAS, informs the registrations for the following courses, in the period indicated, in accordance with the provisions of the rules below:

1. Course for Parafencing Coaches
2. Course for Parafencing International Referees
3. Course for Parafencing Classifiers

1. COURSE FOR PARAFENCING COACHES

1.1. GENERAL COURSE OBJECTIVES

To train Parafencing professionals, especially from countries on the American continent, to work with Wheelchair Fencing - ECR (parafencing), enabling them to:

- Plan and execute parafencing training.
- Act as a Parafencing coach in a fencing hall.
- Plan and organize educational, recreational and competitive activities.
- Assistance in the refereeing and organization of parafencing competitions.

1.3. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

The candidate indicated by the National Federation, who attend the following requirements, will be eligible to participate the International Course for Parafencing Coach:

- Minimum age: 18 years old
- Experience as an Olympic Fencing Coach or,
- Be a fencing athlete for more than 4 years. Must submit a statement from a Master proving the practice of fencing for more than 4 years
- Complete the registration form available on the CBE website. Check the link bellow
- Have knowledge of the English language (secondary level).
- be present throughout the course, in the city of São Paulo, Brazil.

Observation: according to Federal Law No. 9,696/98, which regulates the Physical Education Profession, the Brazilian Fencing Confederation does not have legal competence to enable professionals not trained in Physical Education to regularly exercise the profession of fencing technicians in the national territory, to the extent that this qualification is the exclusive competence of the CONFEEF and Regional CREFs class bodies.

1.5. NUMBER OF VACANCIES

15 places will be made available in total:

- 12 places for foreign technicians
- 3 places for Brazilian technicians

Each student may bring 1 athlete to accompany them on the Course, for this, the athlete registration section in the registration form must be filled out.

Have a minimum of 90% attendance in the course

2. COURSE FOR PARAFENCING REFEREE

2.1. GENERAL OBJECTIVES

Enable referees to act as National and International Parafencing Referees, in accordance with the IWASF Regulation and the National Technical Regulation, enabling them to:

- Act as an referee in national and international competitions in the various weapons and categories.
- Standardize referee's procedures

2.3. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Have knowledge of the IWAS Technical Regulation.
- Minimum age of 18 years completed by December 31, 2020.
- Complete the registration form, available on the CBE website.
- Respect the rules and apply them systematically.
- Have knowledge of the English language (secondary level).
- Be available in person during the full time of the Course, in São Paulo, Brazil.

2.4. CALENDAR

- Period: from September 27th to October 03rd, 2021
- Time: from 08h:00 to 17h:00

2.5. NUMBER OF VACANCIES

12 places will be made available in total:

- 03 places for Brazilian's students
- 09 places for students of countries in the America (1 student per country)

Vacancies not filled within the deadline may be used by Brazilian referees, appointed by the CBE.

2.6. APPROVAL CONDITIONS

- Have a minimum of 90% attendance in the course
- Obtain at least 8 in the theoretical proof
- The practical test will be held at the IWAS Satellite Tournament on October 1st to 3rd, in São Paulo, under the supervision of a member of the IWASF Referee Committee and a member of the CBE Referee Commission.
- Only students approved in the theoretical test, will participate in the practical exam.
