INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

- **At 12h00 on the day preceding the event the Directoire Technique will publish at the Competition Venue and on the internet:**
 - the list of participants by country
 - the list of participants by initial ranking
 - the list of participants by initial ranking (drawing pools in the Junior & Cadet World Championships)
- **At 15:00, the deadline expires for any remarks, objections, or withdrawals submitted by delegations to the Directoire Technique, in accordance with FIE Organization Rules (Art. o.38).**
- **No changes will be accepted beyond this deadline.**
- **At 16:00 the composition of the pools will be published at the Competition Venue, on the website for each weapon on the day preceding the event.**
- **At 17h00 - in the official hotels, the Directoire Technique will publish the following information:**
 - final composition of the pools.
 - times and pistes allocations
 - competition format



JUNIOR TEAM COMPETITION

- The Directoire Technique must be notified of any changes related to the teams by 16h the day prior to the event.
- Direct Elimination tables will be posted in the competition venue (Information point, TV LED, Web site fie.org on the QR on your accreditation) and official hotels the day preceding the team event at 17h.
- Direct Elimination tables on the competition day will be posted in the competition venue, (Information point Level 1 TV LED, Web site fie.org on the QR on your accreditation)
- The drawing of lots to place the teams up or down on the match scoresheet, according to the Rules, will be held where indicated by the DT.

IMPORTANT NOTE

All classifying rounds and direct elimination rounds up to the table of 64 will take place at the Velodrome and at Arena Carioca 1.

Starting from the table of 32 in the direct elimination phase, the events will be held exclusively at Arena Carioca 1.





ACCREDITATION & CONFIRMATION

- The accreditation office and the financial desk will remain operational from **March 30 to April 7, 2026, from 08:30 to 17:00**, in the South Area, Level 01 of Arena Carioca.
- Participants, athletes, and coaches will not be granted access to the competition area without valid accreditation.
- Accreditations must be collected by 14:00 on the day prior to the athlete's first competition and will only be issued upon payment or proof of payment of the registration fees.
- Delegation officials must appear in person and present the passports/IDs of all delegation members in order to receive their accreditations and must settle payment for all events in which their athletes will compete.
- Fencers without a head of delegation will receive their accreditations personally or through their guardian, and must present their passports/IDs, as well as complete payment for all events in which they will compete.
- Up to 15 days before the start of the competition, payment via invoice will be accepted.
- At the competition venue, only credit card and cash payments will be accepted.
- Payments due to the FIE (if any) must be made from the **30 March to the 7 April** to Sandra Baroni, FIE Account Manager.
- All necessary information for registration may be obtained on the event website or by scanning the QR code available at the accreditation desk.

Parents of athletes and other spectators do not need accreditation to access the Carioca Arena and the Velodrome.

PUBLIC ACCESS

Public access to the Cadet and Junior World Championships will be free of charge. Attendees are kindly asked to donate 1 kg of non-perishable food. All contributions will be allocated to organizations that support individuals in socially vulnerable situations.





ACCESS TO THE FENCING AREA

- Only the designated officials, fencers, referees and pistes staff are granted access to the pistes.
- No access will be granted to the coloured pistes, podium fencing area, team boxes without sport shoes and long pants.
- Athletes in the fencing area must keep their belongings in closed fencing bags at the end of the piste.
- Large fencing bags are not accepted in the competition area (FOP).

Individual competitions (Pools):

The coach, team captain and official representative of team are forbidden to be in the competition area during the pools.

Individual competitions DE:

- Only one coach per athlete is allowed to stay in the team box.
- Athletes should be present in the Call room 20 minutes prior to the beginning of the DE-T32 (weapon control)
- Only athletes are allowed in the Call Room.

Junior Team events:

One coach and one additional person are allowed in the team box during the team event. (Only 6 persons max- 4 Fencer + 2 persons)

All athletes and referees must be present:

- on the piste 15 minutes before the beginning of the pools
- on the piste 10 minutes before the beginning of the DE
- athletes should be present in the Call Room 20 minutes before starting from T32
- Athletes should be present in the Call Room 20 minutes before the beginning of the ceremony of presentation of the athletes (FINALE)



MEDICAL STATIONS

Medical stations will be located at the Field of Play at Arena Carioca 1 and at the Velodrome.





WEAPON CONTROL

▶ **Weapon control may only be performed once accreditation has been completed.**

Requirements regarding the equipment

- All the equipment must be in line with FIE regulations and will be checked under control of the FIE SEMI Commission. For team competition all fencers must have the same uniform including the socks. The list of accepted items is mentioned on the table below.
- It is mandatory to put the national logos on both legs of the breeches.
- The name of the athlete and the country code must be printed in dark blue on the back; the size of the letters should be between 8 and 10 cm high. All the prints must be readable.
- All the advertising and manufacturer logos must be in line with the FIE Publicity Code and will be checked.
- After collecting the equipment, it is necessary for the athletes to check the control marks.
- For additional information, please, see m.38, m.39 of the FIE Material Rules.

<p>Electric jackets</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The conductive jacket must be made so that when it is laid flat there is a straight line between the point of junction of the lines of the groin and the two points corresponding to the tops of the hip bones (ilium). • The control of electric jackets will be carried out in two steps: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Firstly, in the Weapon Control room checking the respective electrical parameters and geometric dimensions. ◦ For the second time, the electric jackets will be checked in the Call Room by the referee, while the athlete is wearing the jacket. The purpose is to check whether the electric jacket is fit for the athlete's body.
<p>Breast / chest protectors</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The use of a breast/chest protector (made of metal or some rigid material – see m.25.4) is compulsory for women and optional for men. In foil, this breast/chest protector with a special soft layer must be worn below the protective plastron. • The soft layer has to be approved by SEMI FIE and has the FIE logo.
<p>Masks</p>	<p>All the participants in this Junior and Cadet World Championships have to fully comply with the new rule concerning the new fastening system of the mask (m.25.7)</p>
<p>Mask Design</p>	<p>Masks may feature coloured designs, on the condition that they are approved by the FIE.</p>



CONFIRMATION OF RESULTS

- The fencers are responsible for checking if the results in their pools and the DE sheets are recorded correctly. The screens placed in different locations will allow a quick verification of the updated results of the round of pools and DE matches.
- To avoid any kind of error, the DT will publish the results of the pools and the list of qualified and eliminated fencers as soon as the round of pools is over.
- Delegations must submit any protest to the DT within 10 minutes. After this deadline, the ranking will not be modified.
- The DE tables, together with the schedule and pistes, will be posted after this 10 - minutes period and after each round of DE.
- Only the documents signed by the TD and posted on the information board are official.
- No calls will be made via microphone.



ORGANISATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL DIRECT ELIMINATION TABLE T32

- For T32 all fencers must be present 20 minutes before the scheduled beginning of their matches.
- Fencers must be present in the Call Room 20 minutes before the scheduled beginning of their matches to be led to the coloured pistes at the scheduled time.
- Coaches are not allowed to be in the Call Room
- The bag is to remain closed for the entirety and put in the team box under the supervision of the volunteer. During the one-minute break, or when it is needed, the volunteer will bring to the athlete a chair and the spare weapon. Athletes are to leave the Call Room ready to fence, mask in hand and weapon already plugged into their body wires.

Attention!

- In case the fencer is not present in the Call Room at the appointed time (according to time specified in the schedule) the sanction in the rules (art t.118-119) will apply.





ORGANISATION OF THE TEAM DIRECT ELIMINATION TABLE

- For the T64, T32 and T16 teams must be present at the piste 10 minutes before the scheduled beginning of their bouts.
- All teams taking part in a final stage of tournament (T8-T4) must be present in the Call room 25 minutes before the beginning of the tournament.
- Equipment Control in the Call Room will be from T4 (in earlier stages equipment control will be made on the pistes)
- Equipment will be controlled in the team boxes during the matches T8-T4-Finale.
- The teams will have designated areas, sectioned off by barriers, near the coloured pistes and pistes № 5-8, 9-33. Team members must remain within these areas during the team matches.

Attention!

- In case the team is not present in the Call Room at the appointed time (according to time specified in the schedule) the sanction in the rules (art.118-119) will apply.



VIDEO REFEREEING

- Video refereeing is used in all three weapons from the T32 (junior & cadet) at the individual events
- Video refereeing is used from T16 in team events juniors (sabre, foil)
- Video refereeing is used from T8 in team events juniors (epee)
- The designation of referees and video consultants is done according to art. t.49-t.51 of the Technical Rules.
